The aim of our international workshop is to raise awareness and discuss the common challenges in online teaching during Covid-19 pandemic, as well as how these challenges have been solved by the academic teachers.

We will focus on:

- exchange of the experiences and good practices to adapt digital skills in online courses
- tools that can be used in online teaching
- plans related to online teaching

The presentations will give us insights in online teaching during pandemic. We will also present the preliminary results of InCompEdu project, and project's current and upcoming activities.

With the help of questionnaire, we have identified challenges and problems as well as best practices of academic teachers in the partner countries of InCompEdu: Croatia, Finland, Italy, Poland, Romania and Slovenia. Based on the results, we will publish a "*Report on identified challenges and problems*". The results include challenges in the phase of sudden shift to online teaching in spring 2020, as well as how they were solved. We have also information on the situation in May-October 2021, when online teaching was ongoing for another year.

In the questionnaire and in the currently ongoing interviews, we have also identified a number of best practices related to teaching methods in the online mode. Based on interviews, a publication "*Good examples - Teacher Stories*" – will be compiled.

In the afternoon session, we will organize working groups, in which we will discuss more in-depth the best practices and themes.

The best practices identified include the following themes:

- Preparing for the lessons/lecture; e.g. guidelines and procedures, pre-recorded lectures
- Collaboration with colleagues; e.g. teaching, testing
- Platform-related solutions with various possibilities, combining tools and applications during a lecture and asynchronously
- Various examples on teaching methods used online
- Activation and communication with students
- Students' communication with each other
- Verification of knowledge / evaluation
