- Report on software or tools used for online teaching activities will be the separate booklet (not Part 1 which was assumed first)
- Upcoming activities Delphi analysis
 - UP sent the draft of the report for the 1st round of Delphi analysis (file available on Teams, partners are informed via email)
 - Partners send a report of 1st round analysis - 28th of February
 - UP send a summary of 1st round of Delphi to partners not later than 15th of March 2022
 - Partners start with 2nd round of Delphi (to be completed by the end of March)
 - Partners send a report of 2nd round to UP not later than 15th of April
 - UP prepares the final version of the report not later than 15th of May

IO3: Reimagining online courses for the future of high education

Task 1: Developing innovative online curricula

- Selection and invitation of academic teachers/students/University Authorities to DTW – 15 March 2022
- Preparation of guidelines for DT workshops on how to conduct workshops in the DT methodology – 25 March 2022
- Conducting one-day training sessions for project partners, teaching them how to organize Design Thinking Workshops (DTW). This event will be organized for the representatives of partners who will further organize DTW at their premises and for those who will test the methods developed during the DTWs – 28-30 March 2022/4-6 April 2022/6-8 April 2022
- Preparation of a draft of innovative scenarios/methods developed during DTW and report on results to LIO3, who will prepare the first part of IO3 deliverable – May - July 2022
- Development of scenarios for the modal lessons – July – September 2022

Task 2: Reshaping online lessons

Specific objectives:

- Selection of participants in model online lesson. UNIRI FTHM, UP, UG will test innovative scenarios/methods derived from DTW. Scenarios will be evaluated by students and teachers in October 2022
- Modal lessons – preparation and conduction – October - November 2022

Result: Evaluation of the report and preparation of a "Towards effective courses" booklet. Delivery of a report and "Towards effective courses" booklet – January - March 2023

Ad. d Short-term joint staff training events in Poland (March 2022)

Training activity that will support IO3 take place in Gdansk (03-04/2022)

UG will also organize **special intensive training** for UP, UNIRI FTHM, UAB, UNITOV

- Design Thinking (DT) methodology,
 - how to apply the DT method,
 - smart innovative solutions for online teaching (methods/equipment) in higher education,
- the knowledge and skills to organize their DT workshops,
 - The training will be carried out by **2 certified DT moderators** with relevant experience in this area (UG staff).
 - An intensive 1-day training for representatives of all participating organizations – 18 participants (3 per UR, UP, UTV, UAL, 2 from UTU, and 4 from hosting organization.).
 - The practical knowledge about the development of innovative products using the DT methodology can also be used further by the project partners to continue the work on the transformation of online courses.
 - UG will also organize special intensive training for UP, UNIRI FTHM, UAB, UNITOV
 - DT methodology,
 - how to apply the DT method,
 - smart innovative solutions for online teaching (methods/equipment) in higher education,
 - the knowledge and skills to organize their DT workshops,

 - This intellectual output will produce one deliverable - a booklet „**Towards the Effective Course**” presenting innovative concepts of effective online classes as well as innovative tools/methods of learning and working in online group stimulating creativity, and teamwork (**Deadline: March 2023**); the results of a series of workshops conducted by the DT method and tested during model lectures/classes.
 - in IO3 we plan to conduct 3 DT workshops at the national level and 3 model classes

Transferability:

- The results of the project can be replicated in horizontal dimension: HEIs that did not take part in the project can use them. This concept is also replicable in the vertical dimension as it can be applied to different levels of the education system.

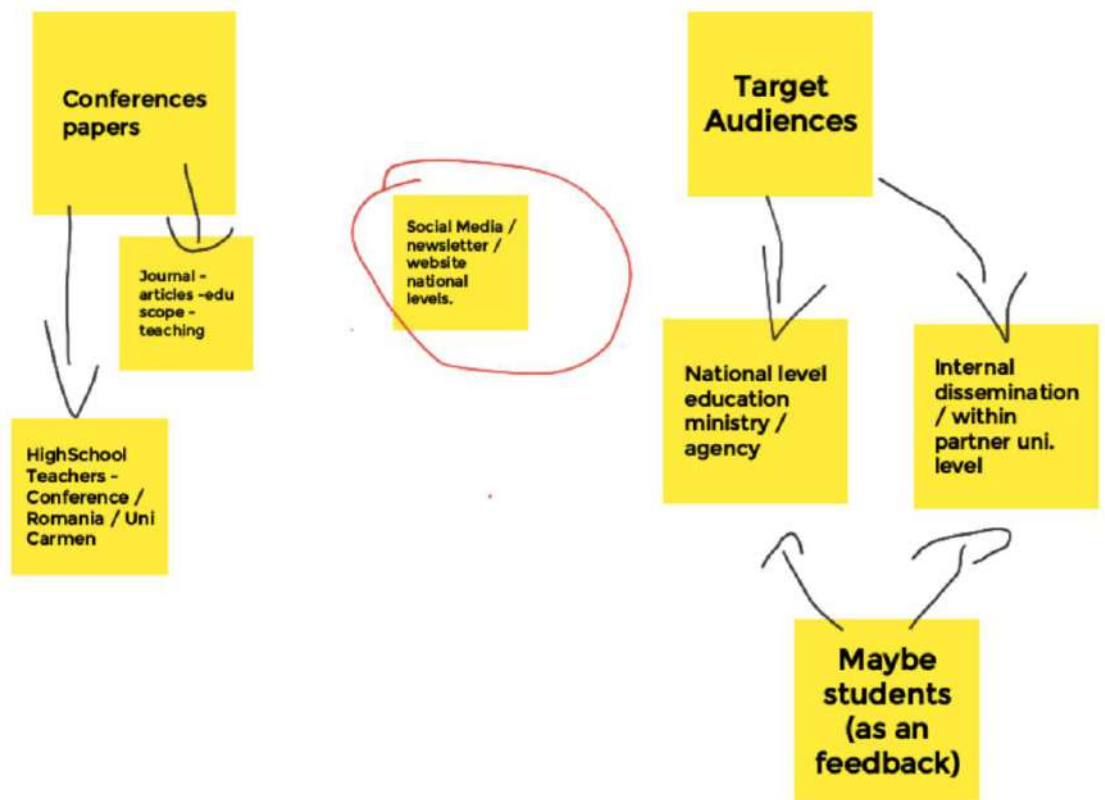
